


Fellowships

SUMMER 2024



Since the pandemic, Inspiring Teachers has increasingly moved towards designing programs and tools that schools in Africa can run independently to support teaching and learning.



Over the last two years, we have been vigorously testing our tools and iterating our programs in testbed environments in Uganda and Ghana.

During this process we've used feedback from partners, school leaders and teachers to fill gaps in what we offer to improve and expand support for all levels of the system.

Our programs and tools now support;

- Classroom Teachers to improve their teaching practice
- Early years & Literacy Teachers to improve their teaching of literacy
- School Leaders to support them in rolling out year-round programs and build professional collaborative cultures in their schools
- Coaches and Field Officers to oversee and gather insights on the programs



Our Fellowships play an important role for the organisation.


Having Fellows visit our programs makes it possible for us to convene teachers to deliver institutes, evaluate our programs, gather data on what's working and where there are challenges.

By having someone visit them and support them in their teaching, teachers who participate on our program also get a real lift.

A growing platform for change

Here's a top-level overview of the programs and tools we provide for schools in 2024

Inspiring Reading Program

This new program supports literacy teachers in grades 1–3.

The program introduces teachers to The Science Of Reading and key techniques that make up our 4-part framework.

Teachers receive weekly teaching guides and students use accompanying workbooks.

A range of assessments help to track reading fluency rates and teacher progress.



Inspiring Schools Program

Our schools program supports school leaders to launch and run our structured pedagogy framework in their schools, through regular staff meetings and peer coaching cycles.

Initial training on the framework, how to lead effective facilitation and how to launch the program is followed up by regular school visits and ongoing support.

A set of observations helps us track progress.





SmartCoach (mobile app)

Both these programs are now supported by our new mobile app, SmartCoach.

The app enables teachers to watch videos of teaching techniques, observe colleagues and send them feedback. Teachers can also now take the register and conduct literacy assessments.

School Leaders can manage users, observe teachers, monitor activity and gather insights.

For primary teachers and middle leaders with experience teaching reading.

Fellows who choose this track will co-facilitate training on the Science of Reading and support grade 1-3 teachers to establish an evidencebased teaching routine in their classrooms.

You'll also play a key role in supporting our curriculum design, as well as creating and improving the resources required for the program.

The Fellow Role

- Co-facilitate training on The Science Of Reading.
- Introduce teachers to our literacy techniques and coach them on how to use them in lessons.
- Coach teachers in how to use our 4-part lesson Framework and teacher guides.
- Visit teachers, observe lessons and give feedback.
- Support teachers run weekly student assessments.







For primary or secondary teachers or leaders with a strong interest in teacher development and coaching.

Fellows who choose this track will co-deliver training for school leaders on rolling out peer coaching and then support them to establish a weekly professional learning community in their school.

You'll also play a role in observing leaders and teachers using our observation tools to help us track progress and improve our programs.


The Fellow Role

- Visit schools to work with leaders to launch and implement parts of the program in their schools













Introducing SmartCoach

To support the running of both the Inspiring Reading Program and Inspiring Schools Program we've developed a . mobile app called SmartCoach to help teachers, leaders and coaches learn, observe, track progress and gather insights. 












SmartCoach Features

As Fellows you will be able to download the app and use it to assist your coaching - the app includes videos and step-by-step instructions of how to do different techniques.


You'll also use it to conduct assessments, whether thats of school leaders facilitating meetings, teachers using a new technique in their classroom, or a student completing a literacy assessment.

Many of our teachers have downloaded SmartCoach, but need support and guidance on how to use it effectively. Part of your role will be to help teachers and leaders to get familiar with the the app.







We provide resources to make it easier for you to ask for support from your school. Generally, schools contribute towards Fellowships in one of three ways:








Create a Fundraising Campaign


Fellow Recommendations
