AISA OFFERS A WIDE RANGE OF DISCUSSION GROUPS INCLUDING:

- Affinity Groups providing a welcoming and respectful space to connect with a community based on shared identities.
- **Community Groups** inviting AISA members working in similar roles or with similar areas of responsibility to connect, encourage, support, reflect, and problem-solve together.
- **Practice Groups** dynamic and interactive online communities focused on disciplined practices.

HOW TO REGISTER

Visit the AISA website **aisa.or.ke** and navigate to Discussion Groups using the website menu.

Once on the Discussion Groups website page, browse the available AISA Discussion Groups.

You will see a brief introduction to the Group, its facilitator/s as well as the suggested audience.

WHO CAN JOIN

Most AISA Discussion Groups are open to all school leaders, educators and co-professionals working in AISA member schools, as well as AISA associate members and strategic partners.

Certain Discussion Groups that focus on shared identities or specific roles have restrictions in place.

When you find a Discussion Group that interests you, click **REGISTER** to apply and request to join the Group.



The AISA team will review the application, and if the AISA membership is verified and your application is approved, you will receive an email inviting you to create a profile on the AISA Discussion Group platform.

Once you have a profile on the AISA Discussion Group platform, you will be able to log in from the AISA website or directly on the Discussion Group platform.



You can access all groups via a single login if you are a member of multiple Discussion Groups.
