

Meto is a nonprofit that exists to increase access to higher education for students across the world.

The Process

- Students complete a Meto profile (~15 minutes)
- Meto shares student profiles with 150 universities and scholarship programs across the world (an evergrowing list!).
- 3. Universities and scholarship programs identify the students that they would like to have apply. Meto puts the student in touch with the university, cc'ing the student's high school counselor.
- 4. Student decides if he/she would like to apply.

How Students Benefit

Institutions know their own institutional priorities better than any student or high school counselor. Therefore, when a student is contacted by an institution through Meto, she gains an essential piece of information: she appears to be a generally competitive applicant.

For students, these connections are a huge win: they go from guessing which institutions might be a good fit academically and financially to making informed decisions about where they will apply.

How Do High Schools Benefit from Meto?

Meto benefits high schools in two ways:

It leads to a more efficient college-advising process and results in better admission outcomes. With Meto, students are contacted by universities that are a preliminary academic and financial match, thus reducing the amount of time that a college counselor needs to spend helping students find realistic fits.

And when a student applies to the right institutions, the final result is that students end up at better-fit institutions than they would have otherwise.
